

## IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION

Yamaha Golf Car has issued a notice to replace accelerator pedal return springs on affected golf cars in the 2016 – 2024 year range. You should receive an official notification from Yamaha by mail in the coming weeks.

While only certain serial numbers within this model year range are potentially affected, we want to ensure every customer has the opportunity to have their golf car inspected for safety.

To make this process as convenient as possible, Carts and Clubs has partnered with The Villages Golf Cars to handle all recall claims for our customers residing in The Villages.
